To the glory of God, the LBM Children's Missions Camp 2017 has ended very successfully. Mission-based teachings and instructions have been handed down to our next generational leaders. The focus was "Paul, God's Servant" and was supported with the missionary story of Madugu – a Muslim child who found faith in Christ and sent the message home to his family. The participants were divided into groups: Paul, Barnabas, Ananias, Silas and Sergios Paulus to depict the missionary nature of the camp. The daily teachings were supported by other activities to bring balance to spirituality such as "witnessing to both children and adult members of the community." A total of 81 kids and 21 staffers (teachers and helpers) attended the six-day event from the 18th – 23rd April at Dawa, a rural community in the Ningo Prampram District of Ghana.

Movement of African National Initiatives

Fifteen countries were represented and many models of Discipleship discussed at the Movement of African National Initiatives continental Congress, held 1st - 5th May in Nairobi, Kenya. The focus was on what would be more practiceable and culturally relevant for the African Church in conserving the fruit of our labour and reproducing workers among the unreached people groups. Discipleship should

become a revolution in the Church to fulfill both the Great Commission and the Great Commandment. Sampson has coordinated participants from Ghana to the MANI Congress on Discipleship for the past several months. The Congress under the leadership of Dr. Obed Uzo met this year.
