Spreading the Good News

Activities among the LBM churches focus on sharing the Gospel in neighborhoods and unreached villages.

1. Get To The Roots Training.

The training in Wa centered on equipping disciples to take the Gospel to children, to families, to communities. One testimony included how one pastor's own son was led to Christ. The support of various Churches collaborated in taking the training to the next level. We have been able to draw on the participation of Churches such as the International Central Gospel Church, Church of Pentecost, Global Evangelical Church and others. Of special mention is Pastor Bede Zuuri who leads a work in Saan among

the Waala people. He was excited about the benefits his village church will derive as mothers in his church will be taught to take the gospel to their own families.

Young people, having gone through a series of Biblical studies, agreed to be baptized into Christ.


