# Fasting for 21 days in November stimulates a renewed commitment

#### 1. General LBM prayer and fasting month

Prayer and fasting was observed successfully in all branches. Missionary families and individual members were duly covered. The time offered opportunities for God's covenant with the LBM to be renewed. Sampson

visited the Church in Togo (see photos at right) to encourage them in standing fast in the will of God despite the political upheaval and street demonstration which was ongoing at the time of the fasting and prayer. Throughout





the daytime prayers, night vigils and individual intercessions, we are assured of God's presence. We are therefore very hopeful of the future and trust that we shall be "Occupied Till He Comes." We are renewing our commitment on theme for 2018 "Walking in Step with God's Mission - Missio Dei." May this New Beginning lead us to higher dimensions in our walk with the Risen Lord and Master of our calling.

#### 2. Bearing Fruit

The Get to the Roots Project aimed at reaching young hearts has started producing results as some of the trainees have started the expected Good News-Clubss in their communities. It is exciting to hear from

trained teachers that kids are responding to the gospel meetings being held. So far, kids are meeting in more than five different locations for Bible Studies and other creative learning activities. The next phase of training for Teacher Development under the GTTR is scheduled for January 2nd to 12th, 2018, again in the Upper West region of Ghana. We ask prayer for God-directed and willing individuals who are obedient to His call to reach the next generation for Christ. "Unless the younger generation understands God's foundation for the Church, the future is seriously at risk."

with their professions and lifestyle 2 Tim 4:12.


#### 3. GEMA MISSIONFEST

The three day event addressed issues of the Church's readiness to reach the unreached in appropriate and strategic ways within one generation. The highlight was the active involvement of the younger generation. Featured focuses include prayer (led by Jason Mandryk of OM & OW fame), Christlike Dis-

cipleship and The World of Islam. Teams from the mission field came to learn and share their experiences as well as testimonies.


Bottom left: MissionFest 2017 included an emphasis on involving younger people in outreach.
