## Making and Supporting Disciples

This month's activities focus on growing adults

### 1. LBM Pastors & Missionaries Retreat

The leaders met at Dawa (5th - 8th February) as they waited on God for directions while praying intensively through the needs, programs and crucial decisions affecting LBM's future. Of great concern was funding for missionary and development projects such as the 20 acre farm in Ve Kolenu in the Volta region of Ghana. At the same gathering the leadership was introduced to the The Timothy Initiative which supports Church planting and Church multiplication.

### 3. Collaboration with Reaching the Unreached in Ghana and Togo.

Sampson and Mike Ahiadzonu visited the missionary base in Togo North. Deep discussions focused on

raising and releasing next generation leadership for the local churches planted amongst the Moba, Gourmanche, Chokosi, Muslims and some other tribes from Burkina.

Report on upsurge of occult practices and witchcraft in Togo was also discussed. False churches and practices are becoming common place. I had meetings in Zebilla and crossed over to visit 2 churches in Burkina Faso. Meeting under trees is not a thing of the past. Some members bring their home chairs to come and hear the word of God preached.

We visited the community head and asked permission for land to be granted for a church building in Adabomasa. We also met at Akuboug where the leader is quite active.

**4. Missions Awareness Conference.**

The LBM also collaborated with the Ghana Evangelism Committee and the Rhema Full Gospel Church, Woe to bring about 70 Pastors and Church leaders together for a two-day training on the state of evangelization. Participants drawn from the Keta Municipal area were also blessed with tools for effective ministry. There are promises of getting back to the area for Evangelism and Missions training whilst we plan to reach a different community of Pastors and Church leaders.
