## How can they believe if they have not heard? Outreach to the Dangme people in Dawa wins souls

### 1. Fruitful Witness to the Lordship Of Jesus Christ.

In answer to fervent prayer, the Holy Spirit's presence was manifested through the LBM Annual Missions Convention and Evangelistic Outreach held at Dawa in the Dangme community from 1st - 5th August 2018. A new church has been born with souls from the evangelistic outreaches. Please pray against demonic strongholds and human waywardness that fight new converts. We praise God for some level of support the new Church is enjoying. God is at work, and we trust Him for an effective discipling process which leads to

effective growth of this work among the Dangme, Ewe and some Northern (Kusaal and Kasena) people of Ghana.

### 2. When Disciples Make Disciples.

James Apam is a graduate from the University of Ghana. He is a member of the Living Bread Missions Church who served as a National Service teacher. With encouragement from the leadership, he started seriously ministering Christ to his pupils. He asked for Bible resources and NT Bibles to equip the young hearts. In the process, he has led many to

Christ and also followed up to their homes to lead family members to Christ in Anloga in the Volta region. Pray for other committed Christian leaders to ensure the discipling of these young hearts as James returns to family in search of a permanent job.

### 3. The GTTR Phase 4 Cancelled.

Due to poor patronage, the Children's Teacher Training scheduled for Sawla (26th August - 7th September 2018) was cancelled. The reason remains the same as for the Tumu phase which was also postponed due to the active farming season of the community - it's difficult to have time when the productive season is only once a year. Pray for rescheduling and active participation after the farming season in the North of Ghana.

### 4. LBM Farms Project - Developments.

In the quest to make sure funds are available to sponsor the Gospel, the LBM continues to explore the natural resources available to us. Despite challenges with our vegetable farm project, all hands are on deck to ensure that the 20 acre farmland and mechanized borehole in Kolenu doesn't go waste whilst we beg for money. Sometimes it's even difficult to receive tithes in support of the missionaries because there are controversies in the hearts of Christians over it. May the Lord help us. Our greatest need is capitalization of the farm project.

### 5. Annual Youth Camp & Outreach.

The 2018 Youth camp was held at Nsawam (22nd - 26th August) on the theme: You Youthful Days... The Lord's Missions. The focus was on using the giftedness and professional expertise to serve God during the youthful days. Three days of evangelistic outreach was held and souls won to join the local Church. Other activities included Bible Quiz Competitions and Debates on current and sensitive issues.
