1. Tema - Ashaiman District Joint Service.

On the strength of the adage "there is strength in unity," the congregations in the Tema - Ashaiman District of the LBM moved to fellowship with the M'Agya Fie (My Father's House) congregation and also support them to raise funds to roof their chapel building project which has been under construction for some time. The local congregation is hopeful of relocating to their new abode as soon as the artisans have finished the work on the project. Praise God with us and pray for this congregation for their high commitment to see progress. May the Lord bless all contributors to this project.

2. LBM Missions Farms Ltd.

It's a joy to announce that the decision to cultivate vegetables on the farm in Ve Kolenu has been taken a step further, whilst the plans for tree crop cultivation is under consideration. Apart from the local 'ademe or ayoyo' cultivated May - June, we have moved to some species of pepper and okra. So far, the crops are doing quite OK, and we are hopeful of good harvest after the initial challenges with the 'ademe or ayoyo' marketing.

The old Toyota pick-up has also now been renovated to support the transportation of produce to the

nearest market towns. Pray for faithful workers from the community and our plans to integrate community development and discipleship processes in the farm business.

3. 21 Day Prayer and Fasting Objectives.

bership to seek the face of God and annually re-commit the work to the Lord. It also brings times of revival and refreshment as we humble ourselves whilst dealing with some specific issues on both personal and corporate levels. We also use the period to present the activities of the ensuing year before the Lord for His empowering grace.

4. Annual Planning and Vision Casting meeting (October 1-5, 2018).

Ministers and missionaries from the various branches gathered together to report, evaluate and pray on what has been achieved through the ministry in 2018. Plans have also been put into place strategically to take the ministry beyond the current challenges experienced in 2018. Evaluations reveal there is need to step up on deeper church leadership engagement and member-

ship mobilization for effective ministry beyond the corridors of the local chapel ministry. The Theme for 2019 is FULFILLING YOUR PURPOSE - Through the Power of the Holy Spirit (2 Tim 4:1-8). There is nothing more fulfilling than knowing your purpose and ministry and working at that with all your heart, your mind and your spirit.

5. Churches needing help for place of meeting.

Some of our local churches continue to face challenges with places of worship. One such congregations which is focused on ministry to young people and kids is the Peace Assembly of Tarkwa - Huni Ano. Steps have been taken improve the environment of meeting through constructing access road to the place of meeting which sometimes get flooded. Pastor Godwin and the family are putting in more efforts. Pray for resources to secure the place and make it more habitable and accessible to these young people.
