Reconnecting with Jesus' redemptive ministry



Twelve people were baptized on 11 November from the new Dawa congregation.



1. Baptism in Dawa - Ningo Prampram District.

The process of discipling has started with the new souls in the Dawa congregation which began in August 2018. Twelve souls have been baptized on the 11th of November at Wokumagbe. Joy and excitement filled the air as those baptized connected with this spiritual exercise. Pray with them to remain firm and strong in

2. Togo Church's outreach as part of celebrating 20 years of missionary outreach into the Republic.

LBM's pioneer missionary work in the Republic of Togo began in 1998. As an appreciation to God for church planting efforts, the Togo congregations reached out for soul winning from the 29th November - 1st December 2018. The main Thanksgiving service will be held on 9th December 2018 in Akepe in the Republic of Togo. Pray for all events leading to the day of celebration.

3. Pauline Students' Practical missionary trips.

The nine-month classroom phase of the Pauline School of the Bible and Missions was completed by the students in October. Students are due for a three-month practicum attachment and field/baseline research assignment which takes 2 weeks. Three (3) main teams departed for Techiman in the Brong Ahafo region cum Zebilla in the Upper East region, Denu - Hedranawo in the Volta region and Dapaong in Togo North. We praise God for the results of the field experiences/outreaches so far. The Gospel was preached, souls saved, healings and deliverance administered - many others were touched in the fields. Pray also for the fourth team which is yet to leave for the field.



4. 21 Day Fasting and Prayer with ZOE Convention.

Branches of the LBM were involved in the time of intercession and spiritual exercise. The annual event is intercessory in nature and lifts up the unreached people groups generally and also deal with crucial issues in the life and missionary endeavors of the Living Bread Missions. This year marks the 22nd event and we praise God for hearing us. The pioneer congregation - Vision Assembly in Ashaiman also celebrated the ZOE/LIFE Convention in concluding the season of prayer.
