Ministry Is Still Warfare

1. Disciples Training - Walewale.

We had further collaboration with Reaching the Unreached on training the young ministers and multipliers of the work of the ministry. This training doubled with young professionals who are serving in some remote areas. The time was also spent appraising how some churches are coping under trees in modern times. Some of the young people are doing well reaching unreached communities and planting churches but that is not devoid of enemy attacks.

Attempts to help solve the place of worship problem is still ongoing but prayer support is needed. In community X in Togo, when the members started building, the M community protested and asked for the place of worship to be sent elsewhere. Pray that peace will prevail in this situation.

2. Spiritual Warfare is real.

The El Bethel Church, Ho was forced to relocate due to some pressure in their rented premises. They moved to the permanent site (not

developed) and erected a 12-foot square canopy. Prayers were being said to prepare the environment spiritually when a snake emerged, attacked, rolled around the pastor's wife's neck (Acts 28:1-5), and moved on to bite another member

(Mabel). Glory be to God for the fulfillment of Mark 16:16-18. Both Hannah (the pastor's wife) and Mabel survived and experienced the scriptures and God's faithfulness. Pray for resources to settle this church in their own land.

3. Ministers and Missionaries Retreat.

Between the 4th and 8th February, the LBM ministers gathered and sought the face of the Lord. Decisions were made on opening new fields in evangelism. One such field is Techiman, the capital of the new Borno East region in Ghana. Pray as we seek the Lord for resources to prepare and send the family who is ready to move into missions.

4. Training on Teambuilding.

Sampson was the resource person for the Ashaiman Ministerial Association for February 2019. He spoke on the need for teambuilding and its associated benefits for the kingdom of God. Sampson maintained, "It is important to note that there are very compelling reasons why we should all work at building teams and raising disciples to support the vision(s) God has given us. Just as it was in the case of Jesus as a human, 'death is inevitable (will come when it will come)'. Our work in Christ is only sustainable through the hands we have trained and the people we commit the dreams to" (2 Tim 2:2).

5. LBM Mission Farms Ltd.

Field preparation for the 10 acre plantation has been finished, and seedlings are ready for the rainy season when planting and further cultivation would continue. There is also a fresh start at vegetable cultivation alongside the tree plant cultivation. Efforts at the discipleship

dimension of the project was made when a bridge building process was initiated with the community and stakeholders in February. Thank God for those who care and support us in the business-discipleship project. Pray for Emmanuel Ameku and Frank Domi (farm manager and project manager respectively).

The coconut and mango trees are ready to go into the ground. Pray for the success of the Farm and its three-fold purpose: 1) to provide revenue for the missions, 2) to provide training for local farmers, 3) to provide jobs for local people.
