God Is at Work through Missionary Collaboration

1. The Value of Collaborations.

LBM's partnership with RTUR has seen great light and improvement over the past 17 years when the Directors met for the first time in a missions conference in Minneapolis, Minnesota. The RTUR (Reaching the Unreached) work in Ghana, Togo and Cote D'Ivoire has grown and spread to adjoining tribes. Since last year when new Pastors were licensed as level 2 leaders, much more fieldwork has been done.



We praise God for the partnership and were so glad that Rodney and Malinda could attend the 2019 Conferences in person - marking their 25th visit to Ghana (a quarter of a century's ministry). Pray for a greater level of such peaceful and working collaborations among missionary organizations.

2. What do we do with the Fulani?

Since Capetown 2010, the Living Bread Missions adopted the Fulani for prayer and action. RTUR started praying for the Fulani earlier. The Fulani people group (believed to number about 20 million in Sub-saharan Africa) can be found in countries such as Mali, Togo, Niger, Burkina Faso, Gambia, Senegal, Nigeria, La Cote D'Ivoire and Ghana. Large numbers live in the Afram Plains but there are huge pockets of their population all over Ghana. 'Stories' of their aggression, lifestyle, and uncompromising stances have created security concerns for neighbors. Let's join hands to pray more missionaries and intentional show of hospitality, patience, endurance, and modesty to them everywhere.

We have just discovered a set of Fulani in G* village in the Upper East region. Pastors F* and K* are committed to bring the Gospel message to them and also help teach the 58 young children in the secluded village - waiting for the opportunity to attend formal school.

3. LBM Mission Farms Ltd.

Work continues to progress on the farm located in Kolenu in the Volta region. Eleven (11) acres of coconut and mango planted this year are receiving attention. Normal challenges of agriculture are also emerging, such as some level of mortality of crops (vegetables in the main and some of the tree crops cultivated). We have also started having some confrontation with encroachers in the community. However, we are fully covered by documentations. Pictures of the crop are showing good signs of growth. Pray for more farm hands and the sustainability of this income generating activity which doubles as a discipleship tool. The Kolenu community must develop to enhance the chances of better life for the youth especially.
