Getting to the Roots to Take the Gospel Everywhere



The training in Wulensi in August prepared 45 more teachers to reach children through Good News Clubs in the Unreached communities.

1. GTTR Teachers' Training.

The GTTR Wulensi Teachers' training is the main event in August 2020. This was done in collaboration with CEF, CAPRO and other churches in the Savannah region of Ghana. In all, 45 participants enrolled, went through the sessions and were empowered to sow seeds of the Gospel in communities, schools and churches through Good News Clubs. The training is targeted at reaching children in the Unreached communities through raising and releasing equipped and skilled teachers. We are grateful for those who supported this August training.



2. Testimonies on GTTR update.

This is a testimony a few days after the training: "John from CMC Savannah is doing well - he taught confidently..." and also, in "Ewuledo communities, the teachers taught in their churches on Sunday and will start Good News Club on Friday."



3. Collaborating with 5 Fold Global Ministries.

More than eight countries were reached during a virtual conference to reach the younger generation around the world on Igniting the Holy Ghost Fire, and it was great. The LBM organized a watch party at her main branch in Ashaiman at the Vision Assembly. We are still leveraging on technology to disciple and do ministry. Sampson was among the facilitators and spoke on the Dynamics of Team Building alongside the many other powerful speakers who empowered the next generation.

4. Second anniversary of the Jacob's Well Assembly of the LBM in Dawa.

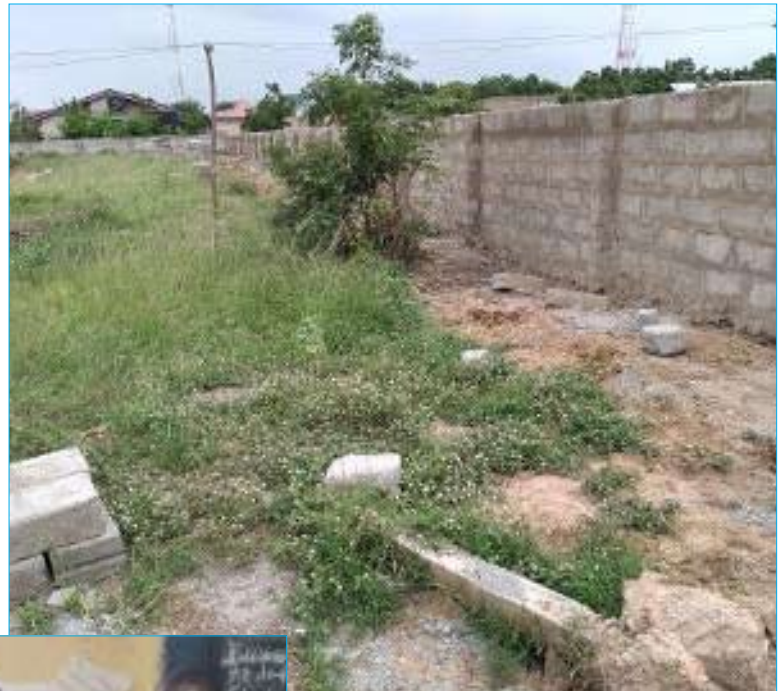
