## We are Praying through the Challenges of COVID 19

### 1. Home Bound Ministry.

Ministry methods and plans have been changed. The lockdown and its impact on church gathering in buildings was felt worldwide. Many are the arguments were raised. However, we do believe that the real church is not the building, but the people – believers in Jesus Christ. This is an opportunity to explore the full Church of God – the Church gathered, and the Church dispersed. There are Biblical evidences that the early Church met as families and in homes (I Cor 16:19; Col 4:15; Rom 16:4-5). We experienced more of this. Whatsapp, phone calls, SMS messages, and Facebook was handy for sending constant PRAYER ALERTS.

Through it all we are satisfied that there was great opportunity to continue making Christ-Like Disciples. Members have reached out to encourage neighbors. As it stands now, the members operate a lot on family sized group levels and close neighbours to read the Bible, study the Bible, meditate, pray and worship Him, the Lord. All these have been done with necessary social distancing and hygiene/health standards whilst at home and life in Christ goes on. Nevertheless, there are some challenges as some other members feel confused over the hold and its impact on economic life since nobody prepared financially for it.

### 2. Conscious of Discipleship.

It was very useful to have prepared ahead of time with our Sunday School Bible Study material which was just handy for use in the small group format of church within the period. It is amazing how these lessons fit into the season as well as the conditions of life globally. Pray for the second quarter of lessons which focus on Discipleship, our main theme for the year. In the meantime, the Discipleship Training Center project slated for the Bono Mission is seeing some action. Isaac and Beatrice Adu-Nyarko are working at getting some blocks locally moulded so the project can kick-start soon. See work in progress. One other place of meeting under construction is the Resurrection Assembly of the Living Bread Missions in Kasoa in the Central Region of Ghana.

### 3. Though not related to COVID 19, we had a family-related loss.

We lost a dear sister – Miss Christine Nuhoho (the younger sister of Mrs. Janet Dorkunor) - through sickness. Her children are directly connected to the LBM and play key roles in the Church, especially Joshua Kartey, who is a lay preacher and disciple at the Jacob's Well, Dawa. Funeral and other observances have been postponed due to the COVID 19 restrictions on group activity within the season. Pray along with us for the comfort of the Holy Spirit.

### 4. Standing In Prayer.

As the COVID 19 pandemic became worldwide, several prayer sessions were held to intercede for the Church, Nations, and those who were affected. We had to pray for our men and women standing the battlefield and members in the various churches. We had to pray for even those who were attacked by leaders in communities where the lockdown was carried beyond the normal. The Prayer Warrior movement of the LBM has been actively involved in prayer covering and intercession for the period under review – reaching the heavens and speaking for God's intervention. Technology has been a big help in this regard and we praise God for His grace to pray whilst under physical lockdown.

### 6. LBM Farms Ltd.

The progress from the farm is remarkable. As the permanent staff takes off with the work and Pastor Emmanuel also gains deeper knowledge in agro-forestry, operations have upgraded and physical growth has also improved. Nurseries are prepared for the vegetable farm whilst care for the mangoes and coconuts are ongoing. Please pray for the protection of Sampson and Moses will be healthy and safe on the farm. We quickly will need electricity supply to boost the domestic functions of the farm – staff are handicapped even in charging their phones for communication. (this is no more a luxury). First fruits are showing up with the mangoes whilst we work at the re-planting of those that were affected by the recent fire gut.

### 5. The Hour of Transformation.

Sampson has continued to minister through “The Hour of Transformation” – a Radio Channel message broadcast through the Faafa FM located in the Volta Region of Ghana with listenership from parts of the Republic of Togo as well. The ministry continues to attract people to make decisions for Christ as well as offer spiritual counselling to others who face different difficulties in their walk with Christ. Please keep praying with some of these people who are threatened for their faith in Christ. The ministry affords Sampson the opportunity to also offer Discipleship Training for others who are keen to learn from him through phone contacts. It's amazing what God can do with all that we commit to Him.
