2. Praise God for Successful Activities:

Women are known to be majority stakeholders in the Gospel ministry since the days of Jesus Christ. The Ashaiman Tema District Women of the Living Bread Mission availed themselves to pray for the work of missions and the Church's growth process. Jesus Christ's instruction to pray for more labourers (Matthew 9:38) is being fulfilled. The women spent time studying the word of God and also planned other ways to uphold the church's growth.

We also thank God for the Youth for Christ outreach in Dawa from 25th to 28th March 2021. The young church shared the gospel and encouraged the youth in the community to remember their Creator (Eccl 12:1). It was a very successful public ministry supported from our guest speaker, Pastor Andy Morrison.

3. Literacy Evangelism Training.

Mobilization for the facilitator training in Literacy Evangelism mechanisms is ongoing. So far, over 40 candidates from 10 churches and about 22 different communities have registered for the skills training. Trained personnel will lead oral learners (in non-formal ways) to read and write. The goal is to empower individuals to connect with the word of God and become believers in the process. We thank God for collaboration between the Living Bread Missions, Torchbearers, Literacy Evangelism (Ghana) and many local churches in Zebilla and other towns in the Upper East region of Ghana. Some of the language groups represented are the Fulbe, Kusaal, Bisa, Tampulma, and Bimoba. Pray for safe team travels and effective sessions from 19th-23rd April 2021. The venue is the Reaching the Unreached Discipleship Centre.
