Isaiah 6:8 Who Will Go For Us?

1. GTTR Buipe.

We thank God for another opportunity to reach out to Christians who are willing to put first things first. Jesus said, "Let the children come to me and do not hinder them, for the Kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." Matthew 19:24. Get To The Roots (GTTR) is dedicated to training and equipping children's teachers to fish for kids in their schools, communities, and churches – mobilizing into Good News Clubs. Seeds of the Gospel truth is sown in their lives and they are given a lifetime opportunity to live out their faith in Jesus Christ. Between the 7th and 13th of August, Janet, Emmanuel, and Alex trained 20 people in Buipe in the heart of Gonjaland (one of the Unreached People Groups in Ghana). We are trusting God for the seeds will bear fruit – 30, 60, and 100 folds.
