1. Mission to the Upper East region of Ghana

We reached out to Pelungu in the Talensi-Nabdam community to inspect and encourage two missionaries working in this area. The team also visited Binaba and reached to the G* village to acquaint themselves with the satisfactory progress of work on the Fulani School project which has reached the roofing stage.

Twenty five professionals from different backgrounds were trained on Christ-like disciple-making. These were from three cohorts and addressed crucial contextual issues related to the Church's commitment to the Great Commission - soul-winning and discipleship.

Disciple-making was the topic of the training during the visit to the Upper East region.



2. Medical Screening

In commemoration of Jesus' love and care for humanity, the LBM Jubilee Medical team collaborated with the health facility (CHPS compound) in Dawa to reach the community. Seven (7) medical staff were deployed to reach 81 people through screening, health education, medication, and counseling to handle malaria, blood pressure, sugar levels and HIV/AIDS cases. Follow up visits and calls resulted in souls won and some community members joining the local church - Jacob's Well Assembly.



3. Get To The Roots

LBM's GTTR training was held for nineteen (19) participants drawn from five Church denominations from Wa in the Upper West region of Ghana. Three facilitators ran the program for seven days: 24th - 30th April, 2022. Soul-winning outreach practicals were done by the participants and some children were won to the Lord. We praise God for the three facilitators, Alex Ofori, Bright Fulidze, and Richard Abo Mantey. It's amazing to see continued efforts towards our future missionaries.



4. Missionary Wives

A cross-section of the wives of ministers/missionaries met to pray, study, fellowship, and plan on their families and the success of the work of the Lord through the LBM (29th April to 2nd May). Strategies on deeper commitment to collaborative discipleship of the Churches was thoroughly discussed.

The Children's Missions Camp was successfully held at Dawa in the Dangme community from 18th - 24th April, 2022. More than 74 kids were registered from various branches. Many activities including Bible lessons, quizzes, Missionary stories, games and sports, etc., were vigorously carried out. Soul-winning outreaches by the kids and teachers reached 118 souls who registered their acceptance of Christ as Lord and Savior. Ten of the souls won attended worship service on Sunday with the group. We thank God for this successful post-COVID opportunity to disciple the kids in missions. We are grateful to the 16 teachers and helpers.

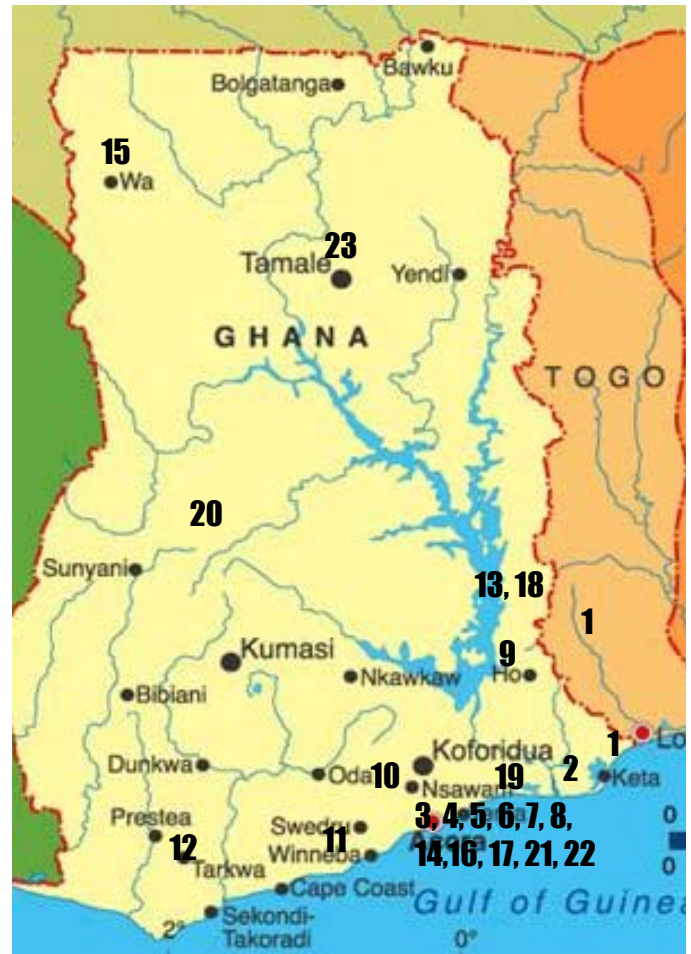
