#### 3. Save A Soul Request.



We praise God for Emmanuel Ameku Mensah and his family who still lead the farm project. All three crops being cultivated are doing well – except for the painful loss of 90% of the mango flowers due to the late start of the rains. In this sense, our hope of first harvest in 2022 has been deferred. The coconuts are also showing signs of fruiting whilst the rice patch has yielded a good harvest! Emmanuel's local church, the Hill Top Assembly, also successfully conducted the burial and memorial services of the late Pastor Alex Akpi who passed away. Pray for Pastor Alex's widow and family to be fully comforted.
