## 1. Ministry to Togo North, Northern Ghana and the LBM Farms.

Tim and Bev Nappe, directors of Reaching the Unreached (RTUR) joined us in the celebration of LBM's 25 years of God's blessings, goodness, and strength in running an indigenous missionary work in Africa. We continued with travels through the fields in Banda, Sawla, Walewale, and eventually spent time with the Togo missionary teams who were negatively affected by the COVID 19 pandemic in terms of interactive and ministry relationships for two years. In September, we spent many sessions of teaching, training, and guidance to empower leaders for the mission work in Togo North.

There were visits to some other fields in Southern Ghana – the LBM Missions Farms in Kolenu. The Nappes visited Pastor Emmanuel Ameku and his family to see ongoing progress. Pray that electrical power lines will be connected to the farmhouse for Pastor Emma and his family to become resident there.

## 2. Children's Ministry Training for impact.

"I grow stronger in the belief that this is the ministry God has called me into – to teach children and to raise able children's teachers all over the world." AB.

To hear this from a disciple who has been sponsored to the advanced level of children's ministry training is not only exciting but meeting the need for intentionality in addressing ministry to children everywhere. Sampson, William, and Bright were three LBM teachers who were sponsored by the mission to attend CEF's most recent Children's Ministries Institute, organized by the West and Central Africa region

(11th July to 30th September 2022).

Two teachers graduated to the level of the Instructor of Teachers level whilst one person graduated at the final stage of Children's Leadership, Strategy, and Development. Another commented, "I look forward to seeing children raised in Christ-like manner - influencing their society and generation for the Kingdom of God."

All the three long-term disciples are fired up to reach schools, communities, and families for Christ. Pray that the 36.7% of Ghana's population (11.7 million) can be effectively reached with the Gospel.

## 3. Get To The Roots (GTTR) Report.

By the Grace of God, the Bincheratanga Children's Teachers' program organized by the LBM ended gracefully and peacefully. Elder Emmanuel Tettey - Tamale, Mrs. Maria Ojo – Wulensi, and Rev. Alexander Ofori –

LBM Children's Co-ordinator - Wa were the facilitators of the 39 participants in the 7-day special training session drawn from two of Ghana's foremost Pentecostal churches operating among the Unreached People groups of Ghana in the Northern region. We appreciate the collaboration



and involvement of the participants to demonstrate ownership of the program. Pray that the impact would be seen clearly and the results multiplied for Kingdom advancement.
