Fulani Education Project launched in the G* Village: The work in the G* village in the Upper East region of Ghana has taken on a new turn when the keys to the two classroom facility was handed over to the chief and elders of the village. The Fulani community finally agreed that some of their many children will start the new journey to formal education. Pray for growth, fruitfulness and long-term development of this and other Fulani communities. Pray also for faithful teachers to handle this all-important work.

The keys to the first Fulani school were handed over last month, along with books and desks for the children. Curiosity and ceremony ruled the day.
