1. The Fulani Project Update.

To the glory of God, the G* Fulani School project has taken off officially. Joseph Apambilla has offered to teach these kids and bring the message of Christ along as they engage in formal education. Reading materials and other teaching and learning materials are gradually being provided to enhance the work. A key need in this

project is two motorbikes to facilitate the movement of the teacher and another facilitator of the project. A recent visit by Pastor Kojo Issaka and Daniel Dauda* proved very useful as Dauda shared in Fulbe with the community from his experience as a Fulani follower of Christ. May this blessing impact the G* community and touch many more lives!

2. Friends Day Report.

Thanks to friends who joined us on Saturday, 28th May 2023 for the Annual Friends' Day. We shared on our disciple-making efforts, practical missionary outreaches, the celebration of our 25th Anniversary, our community development programs, and our major focus on the next generation. Of particular mention are the Professionals in Mission program and the Get To The Roots explorations within the year of accountability. Great results are coming through our collaborations, partnerships, and support from groups such as the OTTN, Operation Christmas Child - Samaritan Purse (touching many children), and Reaching the Unreached. The occasion was preceded by the LBM Ministers' Council which considered some critical issues related to the growth and expansion of the work.



3. Creating Missions Awareness.

The Rhema Full Gospel Church collaborated with the LBM to mobilize many leaders of local churches for a missions conference dubbed: Equipping for the Great Commissions on the 12th and 13th May, at Woe in the Keta Municipality of the Volta region. Hearts were stirred, and we pray for a greater harvest for the Kingdom as more Church leaders and members launch into the deep.
