1. Pauline Institute of the Bible and Missions.

The students of the Pauline Institute continue to receive necessary preparation to take the Gospel to all categories of people. Lessons on community development, child evangelism, salvation and redemption, and Islam were featured in the last few months. Since Islam is one of the core concerns among the Unreached People Groups, it is a vital component to be understood. Pauline was privileged to receive the ministry of Rev. Jeff Korum of Awaken to the World. Much light was thrown on the principles and processes involved in ministry to the Muslims.

2. The Fulani Mission Outreach.

The Fulani School in G village continues to grow. Children who have never been to school have now started counting numbers, pronouncing words clearly, and are equally excited to be in school. The teacher, Jaco* (not his real name) is happy and zealous in taking these kids on the new expedition of life. Aside his commitment to this job, Jaco does part-time farming to help his young family survive. The Special Appeal for a motorcycle still continues, which would enable Jaco reach his students and minister in the surrounding communities for the Lord.
