In spite of all these, seeing that the Cinkasse Community Church which was demolished was re-constructed and in use brought so much joy. The missionary - Francois Agblegou and his family have also been relocated to a new home, and there are plans to take the work to a new level. All other missionaries and pastors are doing well.
