Reaching others in many ways

Developing leaders and disciples takes prayer, plans, and support

1. The Challenge of Sustaining Our Heroes of Missionary Endeavors.

Great men and women have served in the Ghanaian and African church mainly over the last generation of 40 years. Have we provided for their survival beyond the bush and pulpit? If not, how do we expect to help them and their families cope with harsh and stressful economic conditions in Africa? The Church cannot pretend to be an island, and her heroes cannot be sacrificed on the altar of poverty. Our missionaries are aging and leaving the fields, one after the other. Their family is as well aging and facing educational challenges. It's time to think and support missionaries beyond retirement. Please pray and support missionaries like Michael Ahiazonu (serving 20 years in the Republic of Togo with a family size of 5).

2. Christianity's Future Lies in the Hand of Today's Disciples.

Do we have the confidence in them, and can we in God's leading entrust the Church in their hands? We interviewed several candidates and disciples to be assigned the future of the ACM/RTUR missionary churches. We traveled to Banda, Sawla, Walewale, Zebilla, and Dapaong in the Republic of Togo. Though not seminary-level graduates, these home-made disciples give lots of hope for the future of mission and church growth in the rural settings long neglected. We see a picture of an entrepreneurial leadership who are ready to preach the gospel in the marketplace whilst not disbanding the pulpit ministry. We are raising a "sending generation."

3. Running an Evangelism Training with the Gateway Worship Centre.

Sampson taught the Gateway Church for three days on the theme: "Soulwinning is a Heart Condition." The Church of Jesus Christ is not born to be a pew warming specialty but an explosive detonator whose impact is felt in the community and the world as a whole. The early Church showed the way - from an upper room of a few (120) die-hard followers of Christ to a world of life-changers who turned their communities upside down.

4. Outreach to Ashaiman-Lebanon through Medical Ministry.

In a special collaboration between the West African Trucking Ministry and headed by Beth Ames (assisted by Johnny) in Ghana, a medical team from the US was in Ashaiman through the Vision Assembly of the Living Bread Missions on 22nd July 2018. Over 150 people were seen for various physical checks and light medications. Sport evangelism was also carried out concurrently in the vicinity. The same team saw more than 500 people at the Tema Ports and Harbor the following day before launching out to the Republic of Togo where they ministered in Lome and Blitta.
