The Living Bread Ministry (LBM) recently celebrated another year of mobilizing for missions involvement at its annual convention in August. With around 370 attendees from Ghana and Togo churches, the event focused on the Holy Spirit's impact in reaching the nations for Christ.

Bible teachers were also trained earlier in the year to bring this message to the local churches.

4. Togo Update: Gospel Progress Amid Challenges

We are happy to share exciting developments in Togo, where the Gospel continues to transform lives. Through our partnership with Reaching the Unreached in Togo North, self-sustaining projects are empowering missionary families and fueling disciple-making movements. These initiatives, including farms, livestock, and poultry projects, are not only generating income but also enabling missionaries to focus on spreading the Good News.

We are grateful for the remarkable progress, with **257+ souls won for Christ, 103 baptized and 20+ house churches planted** since November 2024.

As our missionaries and pastors in Northern Togo face challenges, including terrorist threats and regulatory hurdles, we pray for their safety, protection, and perseverance.

The Story of Lazarus Agumah:

Lazarus demonstrated remarkable courage in the face of adversity, continuing his outreach ministry despite the Bawku conflict. One notable event at Kusanaba Primary School on July 3, 2025, reached 45 people, with 12 decisions for Christ (5 adults and 7 children). Lazarus plans to disciple them for further growth.

The LBM Akatsi district recently reached out to Kpotavi and Wudorkpo communities, encouraging and empowering believers. We are praying that plans to enhance local worship centers will come to fruition, further advancing the Gospel in these rural areas.

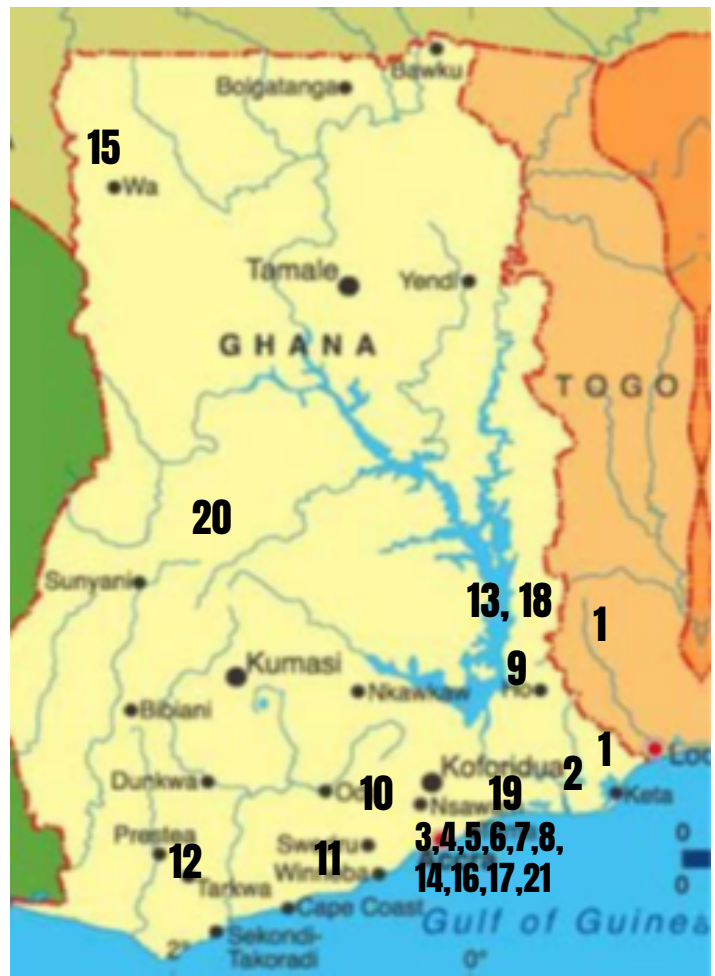
