CELEBRATING THE SEEDS THAT BLOSSOM

"Still other seeds fell on fertile soil, and they produced a crop that was thirty, sixty, and even a hundred times as much as had been planted! Matthew 13:8" (cf Genesis 12:6)

As we commit to hearing from the Lord and investing intentionally in discipleship, we are witnessing God's hand at work. Lives are taking root and bearing fruit to the glory of God. The challenges are real, but so is the harvest. We give thanks that no labour in Him is wasted. With careful and deliberate sowing, we see that genuine seeds take root and flourish.

In this edition, we look back to reflect on key milestones from the past, with a special focus on our commitment to training and raising disciples.

1. From the Northern Ghana fields of Nalerigu, Bujeera is showing deep love to her community by faithfully sharing the Gospel. Trained as a Disciple Maker through the Lines Project, she made a commitment to sow the seed of God's Word. Today, a church has been planted with 64 members — 14 men, 16 women, and 34 children. This congregation carries unique stories of transformation. Though they currently meet under trees for worship, their faith is strong. As a teacher, Bujeera continues to disciple the church through Bible studies, consistent intercessory prayer, and equipping the saints, even as she trusts God for a permanent place of worship. Testimonies abound of deliverance from addictions and transformed lives.

2. Entrusting New Seeds Sown Into God's Hands

From April 6th to 12th, the Children's Ministry of LBM held a camp at Klokpe in the Volta Region. It was a week filled with deep Bible teaching and community outreach. The children and their teachers shared the Gospel throughout the community. 298 people heard the Word, and 33 gave their lives to Christ. We are trusting God that these seeds sown will take root, bear fruit, and multiply.

A new structure is under construction to support increased operations in mango, coconut, and rice cultivation. We are grateful to God for these developments. They are strengthening the work of mission here and giving us hope, even in the midst of challenges.

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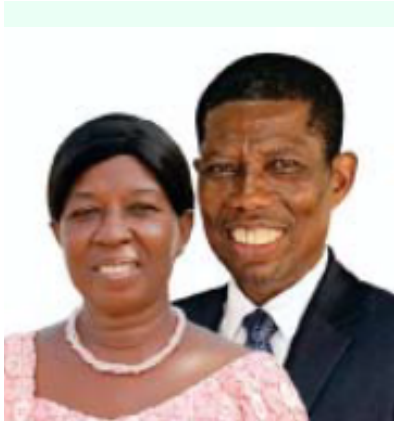
